Interested in visiting more than one location? Check out our memberships below to save money!". The main membership page has big gaps in the webpage between the footer and membership information. This museum offers two memberships but doesn't give you any information on either unless you click on each of the memberships and navigate to their specific page. I don't think it is conducive for easy shopping, having to navigate to multiple links to get information that you need to make an educated purchase. The Port Huron Museum doesn't make any convincing cases for buying a membership and think that they could really benefit from a quote like "Supporting Port Huron Museum's since 2021!" and a bit of structure in their website to make more a better shopping experience.
